- 6. Any other activity Which can help in increasing oral health awareness amongst children, their parents & school teachers etc.



### **Institute's Achievements**

A.M.E's Dental College and Hospital, Raichur Karnataka Department of pediatric and preventive dentistry, A.M.E's Dental college and hospital hosted a awareness program and dental check up in Parivartana Vishesha Makkala Shaale, Raichur - a school for special children. The school comprised of 25 students who were austistic, had cerebral palsy, down's syndrome and who were physically challenged. The programme was initiated with welcome address by Shri Veeresh. Further into the programme a brief discussion and interactive session with the students and parents was carried out. Demonstration of brushing technique and instructions regarding oral hygiene was given to individual parent and student by Dr Bhavana, Dr Sharon, Dr Afreen, Dr. Kausar, Dr Kanchan, Dr Irin and Dr Shiny. This was followed by oral screening of 25 students and distribution of pamphlets. Oral prophylaxis and ART (Atraumatic Restorative Treatment) was selectively done in those required. The programme was organised under guidance of Dr Raghavendra Havale, Dr Shrutha S P, Dr Namratha T, Dr Shiny, Dr Praveen Kumar along with moral support by principal Dr **DNSV** Ramesh.







A study to assess antimicrobial effect of using Coriandrum Sativum, papaya leaf extract and rice Husk Mouthwash in children aged 6-8 years was carried out by students and staff of Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry, A. M. E's Dental College and hospital, Raichur. Study was carried out in residential school and streptococcus mutans count was estimated on baseline, 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> day. All the three mouthwashes showed significant reduction of streptococcus mutans count when compared to Kidodent mouthwash. The formulations were filed for national patent which was published on 18/6/21. Following are the inventions:


### Centre for Dental Education and Research, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi


